

Brûlée Scarf

designed by Cirilia Rose



Materials

- 250 yards soft bulky weight yarn (show here: Berroco Cuzco in #9605 Chocolate)
- Size 6.0mm/US 10 needles (straight, circular or DPN)
- Size 4.00mm/US G-6 crochet hook
- 4 buttons, coordinating or not!
- Tapestry needle

Directions

Using size 10 needles, cast on 28 stitches. Knit every row until scarf measures 48 inches.

Buttonhole row: *knit 4, yarn over, knit 2 together, repeat from * 3 times. Knit last 4 stitches. Knit 6 rows. Bind off all stitches.

Crochet shell edging: Attach yarn at right edge of scarf. *Skip one stitch (each chain of the bound-off round equals 1 stitch), double crochet 5 times around the next stitch, skip one, single crochet around the next stitch. Repeat from * 6 times, single crochet around last stitch. Fasten off. Repeat this shell edging on the opposite end of the scarf, crocheting around the cast-on edge.

Finishing

Weave in all ends. Sew 4 buttons to cast-on edge of scarf to correspond with buttonholes at bound-off edge. Block lightly if desired and wear in good health!
